MR. LIGHT (ARG) allowed to settle, angled out in early stretch, then responded to pressure and rallied to be up in the final strides. RICARDO A rated off the pace while saving ground, eased outside PTAH in the stretch, rallied to catch that rival inside the eighth pole, then drifted to the inside at the sixteenth pole and just failed to last. ATFIRST BLUSH outrun early, split rivals in the stretch and closed well to be up for the show. CACHT WELLS (ARG) unhurried after breaking awkwardly, raced four wide on the far turn, swung wide for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. LOVE YOUR WHIT reserved racing along the inside, rallied along the rail to reach the leaders in midstretch, then steadied in behind RICARDO A just inside the sixteenth pole and was outfinished. CELTIC MEMORIES steadied at the start, was rank under restraint in the early going, chased the leader into the far turn and gave way. PIE CORNER tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and tired. PTAH set the pace along the inside to midstretch and faltered. FORMIDABLE FOX was outrun. BIG OUT chased the pace into the far turn and faded.
