Footnotes

MYSTERY PROSPECT moved up quickly racing down the backstretch to gain the lead, set the pace off the rail, responded when headed by STARSHIP DESTROYER at the sixteenth pole and came on again to prevail. STARSHIP DESTROYER chased the pace three wide, moved to gain a slim lead outside MYSTERY PROSPECT at the sixteenth pole but was outgamed to the wire. PUNTO FIJO (URU) rated off the pace, advanced off the rail to reach contention in the stretch but had no further response. NOTICE ME NOW unhurried after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run and improved his position. FIUMES chased the pace along the rail, angled out for the stretch run and weakened. LOST CONQUEST saved ground and failed to menace. UNTUTTTABLE AFFAIR was through after a half mile. HURRAH set the early pace, raced four wide around the turn and tired.
