DYNASLEW stalked the pace, moved to take over midway of the far turn and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to prevail. MARGARET SMILE reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, angled out for the stretch run and rallied for the place. GRANTED TIGER rated off the pace, closed with a mild response to gain the show. BRIGHT ARRAY stalked the pace three wide, moved into the attending position leaving the far turn, then weakened in the drive. ROMIN ROBIN reserved off the pace, steadied repeatedly in behind rivals down the backstretch and into the far turn, angled out for the stretch run, then failed to menace. PLATINUMPLUS well placed while saving ground, lacked a late response. LA SCORPIANNA was not a factor. ZISTER set the pace along the rail to midway of the far turn, then faded.
