CLOSE IT OUT unhurried after stumbling at the start, advanced off the rail around the turn, eased out and rallied to catch ALDOMEAR at the sixteenth pole, then drew clear while drifting out. DEPECHE CHAT outrun after being caught in tight inside PLEASEANDTHANKYOU soon after the start, saved ground into the stretch, angled wide and closed with a belated rally to be up for the place. ALDOMEAR pressed the pace outside PLEASEANDTHANKYOU, took over from that rival approaching the quarter pole and opened a clear lead, made the pace to the sixteenth pole, then gave way. CONCORDE'S FLIGHT chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. SHANKOPOTAMUS chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then faltered. DOLLAR YO was done early. PLEASEANDTHANKYOU set the pace under pressure along the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then faded.
