Footnotes

PURPLE TRILLIUM reserved racing along the inside, swung out for the stretch run, then rallied to be up late. HUNGRY ISLAND allowed to settle, raced three wide around the far turn and closed well for the place. ROCKETTES ESCAPADE stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, rallied to reach even terms for command at the sixteenth pole but was outfinished. BROADWAY GHOST set the pace under pressure along the rail, edged clear in midstretch, then gave way in the final sixteenth. WET ONE (IRE) stalked the pace, was steadied when caught in behind rivals nearing the end of the backstretch, steadied twice more when unable to get through inside ALPHA CENTAURI leaving the far turn and approaching the eighth pole, slipped through to loom a threat, then was taken up through the final sixteenth when trapped in behind BROADWAY GHOST. ALPHA CENTAURI chased the pace, split the leaders to contest the pace between rivals around the far turn, then tired. SEAUXBELLE saved ground and failed to menace. INFLATION HEDGE pressed the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then faltered. HOME RUN was never a factor. JOYCE saved ground and showed little.
