INDIAN ARM sprinted to a clear lead along the rail, responded when challenged on the far turn and reopened a clear lead, then was all out to last over HIGH CEILING. The latter, reserved racing along the inside, angled out in the stretch and rallied to just miss. BUCKET HEAD chased the pace three wide, made a run to reach the winner on the far turn, was outmoved in early stretch, then didn't do enough late while up for the show. CLOSING NUMBER tracked the pace, made a run at the winner on the far turn, then weakened. GOOD PROSPECT rated off the pace, advanced into contention three wide around the far turn but had no further response. EDGE OF A SHADOW well placed, advanced around the far turn to loom a threat, then was steadied from tight quarters in deep stretch and failed to recover. CAIXA ELETRONICA was not a factor.
