Footnotes

SETTE E MEZZO tracked the pace four wide, made a SETTE to gain the lead inside the eighth pole, then was fully extended to hold off WILD ENTRY (JPN). The latter, rated off the pace after being steadied in the early going, was saving ground when forced to wait for racing room leaving the far turn, then rallied inside SETTE E MEZZO to just miss. STAY RED chased the pace three wide, moved to gain a slim lead in early stretch but couldn't resist the top ones. CHEROKEE SPEED steadied along the inside on the first turn, tracked the pace into the stretch but didn't do enough late. IRENE'S IRISH KID rated off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and gained some ground, then was vanned off after the finish. FIONN never far back while saving ground, gave way in the drive. PAGAN RULER prompted the pace outside IRISH BLARNEY, moved up to vie for the lead around the far turn and into the stretch with that rival, then tired. GOOD ENDING bumped with REVINDICATED at the start and failed to menace. IRISH BLARNEY set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged on the far turn, vied for the lead into the stretch, then faltered. JOHANNESBURG PLACE was not a factor. REVINDICATED bumped with GOOD ENDING at the start and trailed.
