BRANTZEN GONE WILD chased the pace four wide, moved to take over in the stretch, then drew clear under urging. HENDERSON ducked in at the start, moved up to vie for the lead along the inside into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while proving second best. DUKE OF HAZARD rated off the pace, advanced three wide to reach contention entering the stretch, then tired. HANCHO vied for the lead outside HENDERSON into the stretch, then gave way. EL SIMON tracked the pace to nearing the stretch and faltered. MISTER UNITAS was not a factor. PERUSING reserved off the pace, steadied in behind rivals on the turn and never threatened. NEW CROWN tracked the leaders along the inside to midway of the turn, then faded. I'M DANCING TOO was outrun after breaking awkwardly. FORMAL DEPUTY was done early.
