KILLARNEY MIST showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then drew clear under urging. DANCE OF THE TIGER rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and closed to prove best of the rest. SHAHADAROBA chased the pace around the turn and gave way. I CAN SEE A GENIUS chased the pace along the inside around the turn and tired. COUNTRY GREEN failed to menace. CONSOLACION SUR was not a factor. RUTH WONDERS broke to the outside and was never a threat. DOINITWITHSTYLE chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then faltered. INTERCOM reserved off the pace, faded leaving the turn. JEANNIE S was outrun while racing three wide. LYNN'S PRINCESS was through after six furlongs.
