Footnotes

HUDSON STEELE stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through to gain the lead at the top of the stretch, then was all out to prevail. GUYS REWARD stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and finished willingly to gain the place. KRYPTON tracked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the show. DEAL MAKING reserved along the inside, advanced along the rail to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't gain late. OLYMPIC ELECTION (BRZ) set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run, then gave way. LAUREATE CONDUCTOR chased the pace into the stretch, then tired. MYSTIC raced four wide and failed to menace. SO ELITE was no factor while racing three wide. PERFECT BULLET saved ground and never threatened. PERFECT SHOWER trailed.
