BOMBAGUIA stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then rallied to be up in time. OUR NOBLE HEART moved up on the backstretch to vie for the lead outside BUFFALO STORM, contested the pace with that rival to deep stretch, then just failed to last. BUFFALO STORM quickly moved to the fore,

responded when challenged by OUR NOBLE HEART on the backstretch, vied with that rival to deep stretch and gave way grudgingly. JUPITER reserved racing along the inside, eased out in the stretch, then rallied to just miss the show. BLUEMBER stalked the pace, rallied to loom a threat in midstretch, then lacked room behind the leaders late and couldn't do his best. CORPORATE JUNGLE outrun after being caught in tight at the start, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. PERFECT AFLEET rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and finished willingly. IMAGING failed to menace. VALTER steadied and rank in the early going, was not a factor. OMEGA RISING allowed to settle, raced wide throughout and tired. COMPLETE DYNO tracked the pace four wide into the far turn, then faltered. STORMY PARADE saved ground and faded.
