RIVERBOAT QUEEN stalked the pace, eased out and rallied three wide around the far turn, moved to take over nearing the eighth pole, then drew away under a hand ride. FINURA pressed the pace outside BRICKS AND CLICKS into the stretch, then couldn't match strides with the winner while continuing on with good courage to prove second best. WINNER'S LEGACY unhurried early, saved ground into the stretch, eased out and gained the show. ZADINA failed to menace. BRICKS AND CLICKS set the pace along the rail into the stretch, then tired. LADY ROUGE was never a factor. EGOT was outrun. TREQQER was never close after breaking poorly. CORALITA steadied along the rail in the early going and showed little.
