Footnotes

NONSUCH BAY settled in good position for a half, closed the gap along the inside on the turn, angled between horses while three wide to challenge at the quarter pole, charge to the front in upper stretch then drew off in hand to win as the rider pleased. LEAD STORY was unhurried for six furlongs, split rivals on the turn, swung five wide at the quarter pole then finished well to best the others. TONIGHT'S WAGER checked at the start, raced well back to the turn, split horses approaching the stretch, checked behind a wall of horses then altered course to the outside a furlong out then closed late to gain a share. STORMY FROLIC was well pace for five furlongs, raced heads apart outside the winner while angling four wide on the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. KISS ME TWICE raced evenly while saving ground. DANCE THE SLEW set the pace along the rail to the top of the stretch and gave way. SEA MIST never reached contention. WIN'S FAIR LADY prompted the early pace from outside, made a run to challenge nearing the quarter pole then faltered in the stretch. TUFF CHICK raced in the middle of the pack for six furlongs and tired.
