SEDUCER'S SONG stalked the pace after being checked in behind GOLD DANCER on the first turn, rallied three wide to reach even terms for command with GOLD DANCER leaving the far turn, then bumped with that rival nearing the eighth pole and drew clear. MAREN APPROVED unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn and rallied to be up for the place. GOLD DANCER angled outside HEAVY WATERS while chasing that rival around the first turn, moved to take over on the backstretch and angled to the inside, made the pace into the stretch, then bumped with SEDUCER'S SONG approaching the eighth pole, weakened and was edged for the place. FIVE ELEMENTS bumped with EVENTUALLY at the start, chased the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command on the far turn, then tired in the drive. EVENTUALLY reserved after bumping with FIVE ELEMENTS at the start, raced three wide on the far turn and improved her position. CARMEN ROUGE failed to menace. HEAVY WATERS showed brief speed along the inside and faltered. GRANDE GAME was through early. CUPAR showed little and was eased in the final eighth. OPERA SONG stumbled at the start, then steadied in traffic on the first turn, faded leaving the far turn and was eased.
