SWEETBRIAR ACADEMY allowed to settle after being steadied from tight quarters in the early going, eased out on the far turn, then rallied outside FIRE WATER to be up in the final strides. FIRE WATER set the pace along the rail, drew clear around the far turn but couldn't resist the winner in the closing yards. BON BON stalked the pace three wide, then drifted out through the stretch run while closing with SWEETBRIAR ACADEMY to just miss the place. STACY ON THE WIRE rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and had no response when asked. RICH MARQUET failed to menace. BATTERY OPERATED was never a factor. SO LIKE A TIGER stalked the pace along the rail to midway of the far turn, then tired. SAVING GRACIE chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then faltered. PHI SLAMMA JAMMA was through after a half mile.
