A P ASSET unhurried early, angled outside the leaders leaving the far turn, then rallied under pressure to be up in the final strides. STARSHIP FINAL chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over nearing the quarter pole and opened a clear lead but couldn't resist the winner late. LET'S CONNECT reserved off the pace, saved ground around the turn, eased out and closed with a mild rally for the show. EASY ICE rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the turn to loom a threat in midstretch, then weakened. GIDDY UP AMIGO failed to menace. PAST GLORY steadied at the start, raced four wide around the turn and tired. GOOD AND GRATEFUL quickly sprinted well clear while angling over to the inside, made the pace to nearing the quarter pole, then faltered. REALLY LIBERAL raced four wide and faded. LITTLE BRIT trailed.
