LOUISE THE FAIREST unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be just up in the closing yards. LONG LANE rated off the pace, rallied three wide around the far turn, moved to take over at the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner in the final strides. SHE CAN PUNCH reserved off the pace, checked from tight quarters on the backstretch, made a run along the rail to loom a threat in midstretch but was outfinished. JOMARKEL steadied in the early going, saved ground into the stretch and lacked a late response. MY LILIANA was not a factor. MARTY'S JOIA set the pace along the rail into the stretch and tired. ALLURING LASS chased the pace into the far turn and faltered.
