Footnotes

PARTLY MOCHA reserved along the inside after breaking awkwardly, eased out in the stretch, then rallied to catch PLAY EIGHTEEN at the sixteenth pole and edged away. MEMPHISLIVESINME rated off the pace, saved ground to nearing the stretch, angled out and rallied to dead heat with PLAY EIGHTEEN. The latter, bumped with BOB'S PLACE at the start, vied for the lead outside that rival, edged away in midstretch but couldn't stay with the winner late while just lasting to finish on even terms for the place. NONNO'S BOY tracked three wide into the stretch but had no late response. CHAR LENA JO chased the pace four wide around the turn, then gave way. BOB'S PLACE bumped with PLAY EIGHTEEN at the start, vied for the lead inside that rival into the stretch and tired. BEA TOP QUALITY allowed to settle, checked and swung wide leaving the turn to avoid running up on REGGAE MAN, then never threatened in the drive while drifting to the inside. STORM CLOUDS AHEAD well placed early, steadied on the turn, then was forced wide by BEA TOP QUALITY at the top of the stretch and failed to menace. HOLLYWOOD SCRIPT unhurried after being steadied in the early going, was not a factor when steadied along the

inside in midstretch to avoid BEA TOP QUALITY. CIRCLE VALLEY was outrun. REGGAE MAN chased the pace three wide, then was taken up in traffic leaving the turn and faded.
