**Footnotes**

BLUEGRASS JET allowed to settle, rallied and split rivals at the top of the stretch to gain the lead soon after entering the stretch, then was fully extended to prevail. WINNER JAK unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run and closed well for the place while unable to catch the winner. OH SO DEBONAIRE tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch but had no late response. ROAD TO BABYLON set the pace along the rail to the top of the stretch, then weakened. MY POCKET ACE stalked the pace along the rail, was steadied when he lacked room in behind ROAD TO BABYLON in midstretch and gave way. BARTH'S APPROVAL saved ground and failed to menace. STORMY THE CAT rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. TOH'S GREY CAT reserved early, checked in traffic at the top of the stretch and never threatened. UNO AGAIN was not a factor. DR. TOM G chased the pace, had moved to take over when he took a bad step on the far turn, was pulled up and vanned off.
