OOOHS AND AAAHS chased the speed off the rail into mid stretch, took over and edged away under pressure. INDY'S ILLUSION stalked the pace three wide to be up for the place. GO BERNIE GO set the pace along the inside and gave way mid stretch. LENT bumped with RULE NUMBER SIX at the start and flashed only brief foot while off the rail. IN RHYTHM slow early, passed tiring rivals. PALM ISLAND raced up close four wide and weakened. RULE NUMBER SIX bumped with LENT at the start, showed only brief speed racing three wide. MALIBU GLOW allowed to settle, failed to menace. DRAMEDY well placed, tired.
