### Footnotes

MARASCA rated close to the pace from the outside, took over nearing the quarter pole, moved clear into the stretch and was kept to a steady drive for the win. EQUALITY rated close on the rail, was boxed in leaving the turn, gathered some momentum from the top of the stretch and was closing slowly late. LEGISLATOR came out a step slow then raced unhurriedly to the final turn, came three wide through the turn making his bid then continued on evenly through the stretch. MOUNTAIN FORUM, off the pace, made his bid nearing the final turn then finished evenly. STRIVE raced unhurriedly through the backstretch, made a five wide bid on the final turn then was empty for the drive. CHARIOTEER stalked the early pace, took the lead nearing the final turn, dropped back inside entering the stretch and faded. SAY NO MAW raced well off the pace from the outside and offered no rally. RAYMOND SPRINGS was steadied early on and through early. MAJOR FOCUS took the early lead along the rail setting the pace, was under pressure on the backstretch and faded inside through the turn.
