DANDY ROSE forced the early pace from outside, made a run to challenge leaving the turn, dueled along the rail into deep stretch then prevailed while drifting out slightly in the late stages. SO PROUD set the pace under pressure for a half, battled outside the winner into midstretch, fought gamely into deep stretch and just missed. MT. KOBLA was reserved for a half, split rivals on the turn, drifted out while gaining in midstretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. PURELY FABULOUS chased three wide, lodged a mild bid from outside on the turn but couldn't sustain her rally. STYLISH MANNER failed to threaten while six wide on the turn. KENTUCKY WOMAN saved ground to no avail. WAHINE made a run five wide to reach contention on the far turn then flattened out. WILD ABOUT DEBBIE showed only brief speed along the inside. NO STOPPING was outrun.
