Footnotes

DEPARTING SOUTH (ARG) raced off the pace, made a bid to the outside on the final turn, dueled to a short lead in midstretch then kept to a drive to maintain her edge. JUST RIGHT ASHLEY advanced to contention and stalked the pace, moved to a short lead into the final turn, dueled to late stretch dropping back a head but weakened nearing the wire. ASK ME AGAIN drifted out entering the first turn, rated close to the pace then ran evenly to late stretch but had nothing left in the final sixteenth. SALITROSA raced well off the pace on the outside, made a bid widest through the stretch and closed to finish well. LOVE ONE ANOTHER rated off the pace, angled five wide into the stretch and offered no rally. VEGAS ALARM bobbled slightly at the start, advanced to the lead rating the pace, was tested into the final turn and gave way from the top of the stretch. EQUIDEED was reluctant to load, raced off the pace and was through early.
