**Footnotes**

GOLD CURE moved along the inside to gain the lead after entering the first turn, made the pace racing off the rail into the stretch, then increased his margin to the wire when set down for the drive. STONE BRIDGE allowed to stalk the pace after being outrun for the lead around the first turn, was no match for the winner while responding with good courage to regain the place. SIX COURSE MEAL reserved off the pace, advanced along the inside to reach the attending position in midstretch but couldn't sustain his bid. REPORTER tracked the pace three wide into the stretch, then tired. TRIAL OF THE YEAR was not a factor. THROWTHEBOOKATEM was always outrun.
