Footnotes

WALTZING WITH BLUE rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole and prevailed. WINNER JAK allowed to settle, angled out for the stretch run and closed well for the place. MATCHING WHITES chased the pace, made a run to gain a slim lead on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. SKY MAGIC showed brief speed, eased back to chase the leaders along the inside into the stretch but had no late response. WILD SHOOTER reserved along the inside, angled out while advancing to reach contention in the stretch, then flattened out. LAST NOBLE unhurried after bumping with CONCORDE'S CROWN at the start, raced four wide around the far turn and gained some ground. PENALTY KICK bumped with

CONCORDE'S CROWN at the start and failed to menace. CONCORDE'S CROWN was no factor after being jostled between rivals at the start. BIRDCAPER vied for the lead to the sixteenth pole, then gave way. BUNGEE JUMPER was not a factor. HITTERS COUNT was through after a half mile. WOULD AND COULD tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and tired.
