RELAMPAGO unhurried after being bumped at the start, saved ground around the far turn, eased out in the stretch, then rallied under pressure and wore down MODEST late to prevail. MODEST set the pace along the rail to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner while clearly best of the rest. GUNS AND RELIGION was knocked into RELAMPAGO at the start, chased the pace off the rail into the stretch and gave way. RUNYON HUMOR off slowly, failed to menace. COURAGE TO BE stalked the pace to nearing the stretch, then tired. VALTER tracked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and faltered. SMOKING THE FIELD ducked out at the start bumping soundly with GUNS AND RELIGION and was not a factor. BESSELINK was outrun.
