ALLENDAR tracked the pace along the inside, angled outside INHALE and caught that rival approaching the top of the stretch, then was under a confident hand ride to prevail. INHALE vied for the lead along the inside, edged clear after entering the turn but couldn't resist the winner in the drive while continuing on gamely to the wire. HOUR DANCER unhurried early, passed tired rivals. DAWN'A SEZ chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. CALL ME DANCER showed little. POETIC VERSE vied for the lead into the turn, then faded.
