ACT FOOLISH tracked the pace while saving ground, eased outside ORKAN in the stretch and rallied to be up late. ORKAN set the pace along the rail into the stretch and continued on with good courage to hold the place while unable to resist the winner. MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE reserved early, angled outside the leaders for the drive and closed with a mild rally to be up for the show. TWO SHARKY BETTY unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and gained some ground without threatening. SHRIMP TEMPURA failed to menace. LADY PRANTLACK off slowly, saved ground and lacked a late response. TASHA SANGUE prompted the pace outside ORKAN into the far turn and tired. AIR ADAIR steadied along in the early going, moved out to chase the leaders three wide into the far turn and faltered. CATALINA CAT showed early foot, stopped and was pulled up in the stretch run.
