Footnotes

COMMON CHANNEL unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up late. TRIPPI'S HOLIDAY away alertly, was angled over to the inside, eased back leaving the first turn to stalk the pace, was forced to wait for room racing into the stretch, split rivals to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner late. MAGNIFICENT TRUTH allowed to settle, lacked room into the stretch, split rivals to loom a threat in midstretch but was outfinished. KULKA moved up on the backstretch to vie for the lead outside WESTONIA into the stretch, then weakened. MISS BERTILA reserved racing along the rail, made a run to join the leaders in the stretch, then tired. GILDED DAPHNE stalked the pace, made a run three wide to join the leaders on the far turn, then faltered in the drive. POET'S EYE rated in striking position off the pace, gave way in the drive. MECKE'S SWEETHEART unhurried early, steadied in behind rivals at the top of the stretch and never threatened. WESTONIA moved up around the turn to take over from TRIPPI'S HOLIDAY, responded when challenged by KULKA on the backstretch, vied for the lead along the inside with that rival into the stretch, then faded. SENORITA BEITZ was outrun after being steadied in the early going.
