STORM WARNINGS set the pace along the rail, repulsed a bid from NOAH'S HARVEST on the far turn and reopened a clear lead, then was all out to last over EVENFOREVER. The latter, stalked the pace, swung out for the stretch run and was gaining on the winner at the finish. NOAH'S HARVEST chased the pace, made a run at the winner midway of the far turn, then weakened. ROCK ALEX allowed to settle, was racing four wide when steadied on the far turn, then rallied while unable to catch NOAH'S HARVEST for the show. MY SAINT reserved off the pace, made a run four wide to loom a threat on the far turn, then gave way. UNCLE JOE rated off the pace, steadied on the first turn, angled out for the stretch run, then steadied in behind EVENFOREVER in the stretch and failed to recover. STAFF SARGEANT unhurried after breaking slowly, swung wide for the stretch run and gained some ground without threatening. MARK'S SOUL off slowly, was outrun early, then closed ground late. TYLER'S WILDCAT tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and tired.

MAIN RULER was no factor after breaking a step slowly. SIR PHILIP was stalking the pace when steadied repeatedly in behind the leaders around the first turn and into the backstretch, remained in contention to midway of the far turn, then faltered. TATAO TA AKOTAO off slowly, was outrun.
