Footnotes

SNUG HARBOUR moved through along the inside to take over racing down the backstretch, opened a clear lead in the stretch, then was all out to just last over MARINA LIGHT. The latter, chased the pace three wide, made a run at the winner on the turn, was outmoved by that rival in the stretch, then rallied to just miss while drifting out badly under left handed pressure impeding. NO SLEEP reserved early, angled out for the stretch run and was rallying when forced out late by MARINA LIGHT. ANNETTE'S JET off slowly, tracked the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones. JUST A LITTLE JET raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace. PITANGA showed speed off the rail into the turn, then faltered. COMEONGAL was never a factor after breaking slowly. LADY OF LONG AGO trailed after stumbling at the start and was eased in the stretch run. Following a stewards inquiry and a claim of foul by the rider of NO SLEEP, MARINA LIGHT was disqualified and placed third for interference to that rival in deep stretch.
