JOE FIVE steadied along the inside on the first turn, saved ground to nearing the stretch, eased out and rallied to be just up at the wire. SIR HUGHES rank around the first turn while being taken back off the lead to stalk the pace, moved to take over at the top of the stretch, then just failed to last. COFFEE CAKE tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and had no late response. BESSELINK was saving ground when steadied on the far turn, continued to save ground into the stretch, angled out and closed to just miss the show. SOLDIER'S FAITH rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals. AGAIN ELEVEN well placed into the stretch, lacked a rally. GONE STRAIGHT set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch, then tired. TRUST THE DEPUTY failed to menace. EL SIMON was not a factor. MATTY'S CITY SLEW was outrun. THE SILVER TUNE chased the pace into the far turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
