**Footnotes**

STORM SQUALL stalked the pace three wide, moved up to reach even terms for command on the far turn, then dueled for the lead to deep stretch and prevailed. DAY DEE set the pace off the rail, responded when challenged on the far turn, then dueled for the lead between rivals through the stretch and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. AMBASSADOR DAN steadied in behind rivals on the first turn, advanced along the rail to engage DAY DEE on the far turn, then dueled with the top ones through the stretch and was outgamed to the wire. UNTUTTTABLE AFFAIR tracked the pace into the far turn, then drifted out through the stretch and was gaining on the top ones late. BROADWAY BUD chased the pace into the far turn, then gave way. GARY'S BOOMER failed to menace after being caught in tight on the first turn. STORM THIS saved ground and tired. HANGING IN THERE was no factor while racing four wide. BIG ROYAL ELTISH tracked the pace three wide into the far turn, then faltered. HALO BOUDREAUX was outrun after hesitating at the start.
