LOS CAOPOS reserved early, raced four wide around the turn, rallied to catch CHAMPION ECLIPSE inside the sixteenth pole and won going away. TO HEIR IS HUMAN unhurried early, raced four wide around the turn and rallied to be up for the place while unable to stay with the winner. CHAMPION ECLIPSE set the pace three wide to inside the sixteenth pole, then gave way. BEACHMONT FASHION rated off the pace, rallied four wide to reach the attending position on the turn, then flattened out. AMARILLO SKY chased the pace to midway of the turn, then tired. LLEVATELO off slowly, was not a factor. SOUPERMAN HIMSELF well placed while saving ground, faltered in the drive. LISTOWEL BOY chased the pace three wide into the turn, then faded.
