HEY BYRN stalked the pace, moved up to engage FAMOUS PATRIOT on the far turn, vied with that rival to nearing the eighth pole, then edged away under pressure. DREAM MAESTRO steadied when trapped in behind rivals on the first turn, rallied three wide around the far turn to try the winner racing into the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival while continuing on with good courage for the place. FAMOUS PATRIOT taken well in hand while making the pace along the inside, responded when challenged by HEY BYRN on the far turn, stayed with that rival to nearing the eighth pole, then weakened. WEB GEM off slowly, was rated in striking position off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and had no late response. CHIEF BEAR stalked the pace along the inside into the far turn and gave way. NATHAN RIDGE broke slowly, rushed up and was checked while very rank on the first turn, then failed to be a factor. BIPOLAR EXPRESS well placed in the far turn, faded.
