TEXAS GLITTER showed speed outside KIPPERSCOPE, inherited a clear lead when that rival fell on the turn, responded when challenged by JOE'S SON JOEY racing into the stretch and was all out to prevail. JOE'S SON JOEY rated off the pace, steadied when KIPPERSCOPE fell, made a run to reach TEXAS GLITTER racing into the stretch but was outgamed to the wire. TRUE LOVE'S SECRET outrun early, steadied briefly when KIPPERSCOPE fell on the turn, then rallied to be up for the show. POINT OF AMERICA reserved racing along the hedge, steadied in behind the fallen horse, then checked in behind the leader leaving the turn and weakened in the drive. UNCLE ROCCO allowed to settle, steadied to avoid the fallen horse on the turn, raced three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. KIPPERSCOPE rushed up along the hedge to contest the pace, then broke down on the turn and fell.
