NAKEEB well placed while saving ground, angled out leaving the far turn and rallied under pressure to be up late. HEZA GOOD GUY stalked the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the far turn and opened a clear lead but couldn't match strides with the winner in the final sixteenth. SYNONYM tracked the pace off the rail, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones in the drive while closing to be up for the show. COZZENING reserved after being steadied in tight quarters on the first turn, raced three wide on the far turn and tired. ONE NICE CAT was no factor while racing four wide. HE'S A MYSTERY set the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn and faltered. HALO'S ALARM was outrun while saving ground.
