Footnotes

STRICTLY SOCIETY was knocked sideways by NIGHT OF POWER at the start, chased the pace along the inside, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to gain command inside the eighth pole and won going away. DEPARTURES reserved racing off the rail, eased out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. TOP YANK bumped hard with NIGHT OF POWER at the start, set the pace under pressure along the rail to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. BACK ALLEY DEAL pressed the pace outside TOP YANK to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. SLAM FIRE well placed while saving ground, had no late response. NIGHT OF POWER allowed to settle after being steadied when knocked into STRICTLY SOCIETY at the start, gained some ground without threatening. SCOVILLE raced three wide and tired. BIG SKY GUY saved ground and failed to menace. SOUPA MON rated off the pace, faltered. SKIPPER SLEW was outrun after breaking slow and being steadied at the start. MAUI LUAU was never a factor.
