**Footnotes**

SWEET N NUTTY rated off the pace, advanced along the rail around the far turn, eased out, rallied and split rivals to gain the lead inside the eighth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. CANAIMA pressed the pace outside STORMY STORY, moved to gain a slim lead from that rival in the stretch, then responded when SWEET N NUTTY moved to the fore and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. VALID DISTINCTION reserved off the pace, angled out for the drive and closed with a mild response for the show. STORMY STORY set the pace under pressure along the rail into the stretch, then weakened. MICHELLE'S TRIP allowed to settle, raced three wide around the far turn and had no response when asked. ITALIAN NANY stalked the pace into the stretch and gave way. PUT IT ON A JET failed to menace. MEDIA BIAS tracked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. SARAFINA unhurried early, made a run four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then faltered.
