IN SPEIGHT OF IT reserved early, angled out for the stretch run and closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. CUBAVERA rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and closed to gain the show while unable to stay with the top ones. M'S WILL vied for the lead three wide to nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. ALL ON ME was not a factor. TRIPLE A. RATING chased the pace four wide around the turn and tired. NAOS showed early foot, saved ground around the turn and faltered. POWER RULES was done early.
