Footnotes

LAVENDER HILL stalked the pace off the rail into the stretch, then rallied under pressure to be up late. RIGHTEOUSHOPEFUL reserved off the pace, saved ground into the far turn, came around horses leaving the far turn, then rallied along the rail to be up for the place. CORTADITO vied for the lead along the inside, drew clear around the far turn, made the pace to deep stretch and yielded. RICHIE'S REDBULLET tracked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and was gaining slowly at the finish. SCOTTISH COAST allowed to settle, saved ground and passed tired rivals. GAMBARU raced three wide and never threatened. LEAVE IT TO BERN stumbled at the start, then was no factor while racing four wide. BARK SCORPION failed to menace. DR. D R was outrun

and clipped heels in the stretch. INDY WEST rated off the pace, faltered. UNIQUE TUNE was done early. A. P. SIERRA vied for the lead outside CORTADITO into the far turn, then faded.
