Footnotes

LOST AT DAWN reserved off the pace, steadied in traffic on the first turn, advanced three wide around the far turn, angled in for the stretch run, then rallied to be up late. SMART FARMING tracked the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead in the stretch but couldn't resist the winner late. LADY CHARLIE tracked the pace, rallied to gain the lead leaving the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then weakened. VICTORIA'S STRIKE well placed while saving ground, angled to the outside in the stretch for room and closed well late to finish on even terms with ATLANTIC HURRICANE. The latter, rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and finished willingly to dead heat with VICTORIA'S STRIKE. TRUE BELIEVER allowed to settle after being caught in tight in the early going, gained some ground without threatening. IT'S JO JO failed to menace. BAHAMA DRAMA chased the pace to midway of the far turn, then tired. MORNINGSIDEHEIGHTS was not a factor. IT'Z MY CANDY sprinted to a long lead racing along the rail, made the pace to nearing the stretch, then faded. NAN AND MARGE off slowly, was never close.
