Footnotes

LUCKY IRISH DAY chased the pace along the inside into the stretch, then rallied to be up late. ROYAL TROON chased the pace three wide into the stretch and rallied to be up for the place. WILDCAT KID showed speed off the rail, drew clear around the turn but couldn't resist the top ones late. KITTEN'S CAREGIVER rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and closed with a belated rally. PASSING PRINCESS saved ground and failed to menace. COUNTY GUN chased the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. AIM AND FIRE was no factor while racing four wide. CODE TAKER raced three wide and never threatened. ED THE BOXER was outrun after being steadied at the start. GORLOCK was done early.
