POLICE CHATTER rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, angled out and rallied to catch VOYLES inside the eighth pole, then edged away. MR. HAYWOOD allowed to settle, raced off the rail and closed well to be up for the place. HANGOVER KID outrun early, angled wide in the stretch and rallied to just miss the place. BORREGO'S BOY reserved off the pace, advanced to reach contention in the stretch but didn't do enough late. SARATOGA SWING outrun early, passed tired rivals in the drive. GOOD CHEMISTRY well placed while saving ground, lacked a late response. AMERICAN SONG failed to menace. VOYLES showed speed along the inside, then drifted out through the stretch and tired. TRIPPI'S CHARM steadied after the start, moved up quickly to chase the pace three wide around the turn, then faltered. HOME RUN STORM showed early foot and faded. EYES OF BLUE was done early.
