Footnotes

MELODY OF COLORS reserved off the pace after bobbling at the start, rallied under pressure to be up late. DESIRABLE MOMENT showed speed along the hedge, increased her margin around the turn but couldn't hold off the winner late. FORMADA (ARG) off slowly, saved ground around the turn, eased out in the stretch and closed to be up for the show. PETRINA ABOVE rated off the pace after breaking slowly, raced three wide on the turn and closed with a mild response. PEACE SYMBOL unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and found her best stride late. VIBS chased the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way. UNHURRIED outrun early, lacked a rally. PARTying off slowly, raced in striking position around the turn and tired. CUTOFFS chased the pace, then bolted on the turn and was eased.
