Footnotes

FAIREST CAPE stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside ATLANTIC WEDDING to take over leaving the far turn and drew clear under urging. PIMENTINHA tracked the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, was outmoved into the stretch but continued on with good courage to be up for the place while unable to get to the winner. STATUE reserved after being steadied from tight quarters soon after entering the first turn, raced three wide on the far turn and closed to be up for the show. ANNA'S BALLERINA unhurried while saving ground, angled out leaving the far turn, then drifted in under right handed urging in early stretch impeding SEANACHAI and improved her position. BOARDROOM SCANDAL chased the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command on the far turn, then tired. ATLANTIC WEDDING quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the inside, came out a bit allowing FAIREST CAPE through leaving the far turn, then gave way. SUNSHINEOFYOURLOVE well placed early, faltered. HURRICANE HERSHEL failed to menace after being caught in tight early. SEANACHAI reserved racing along the rail, was checked when shut off by ANNA'S BALLERINA in early stretch and failed to be a factor. APPLE ANNIE was outrun. LOTS OF PATS was through early. Following a claim of foul by the rider of SEANACHI, ANNA'S BALLERINA was disqualified and placed ninth for interference to that rival in the stretch. (The rail on the turf course was set at 60 feet).
