Footnotes

UNACCOUNTABLE rated in good position off the rail, moved to the lead between horses approaching the final turn, was pressured clear into the lane and widened to the wire under steady handling. STROLL FOR ACURE, unhurried about the four path, made a bid three wide into the final turn and continued under strong urging to get place at the wire. HOMESTEAD STRIKE rated close two deep, threatened for the lead approaching the quarter pole, dropped back entering the stretch then outfinished for place under the wire. AUTHORITY RULES, slow into stride, settled back inside, angled five wide near the quarter pole and finished evenly outside. HAVINABREW rated a slim lead inside then faded through the final turn. STRAIGHT THUNDER rated just off the pace inside, gave chase into the final turn then faded through the stretch. STING BOY, a step slow to break, made a mild three wide bid into the final turn but had nothing further through the lane.
