BUCKY'S PRAYER chased the pace along the inside, angled out leaving the turn, then rallied to be up in the final strides. CHARLIE PAPA set the pace under pressure along the rail, drew clear in early stretch but couldn't resist the winner late. LADY RIZZI reserved early, angled out for the drive and rallied for the show. HAP E TO RUN unhurried after being steadied from close quarters at the start, was steadied again along the rail soon after entering the turn, swung out for the stretch run and gained some ground without threatening. BEREBBA saved ground to no avail. RGIRLDOESN'TBLUFF broke through the gate and ran off briefly before the start, pressed the pace outside CHARLIE PAPA to the top of the stretch, then tired. SUAVE ROYALTY chased the pace three wide around the turn and faltered.
