**Footnotes**

INTRODUCER unhurried while saving ground, eased outside the leaders in the stretch, rallied to take over at sixteenth pole and was all out to prevail. HALO OF TRUTH outrun after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run and closed well to be up for the place. ROSES FOR RUBY tracked the pace three wide into the stretch, then didn't do enough late while being outfinished. ELTISHA stalked the pace along the inside, was steady to avoid running up on the leader entering the far turn, made a run along the inside to reach near even terms for command with SOUND WAVE inside the eighth pole, then weakened in the final sixteenth. SOUND WAVE prompted the pace outside QUIETLY ELEGANT, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, made the pace to the sixteenth pole and gave way. RIOTOUS MISS rated in striking position off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. MOONLET MINISTER taken in hand to trail, angled wide in the stretch and gained some ground without threatening. LOST HER RANK failed to menace. SULLANA raced three wide and was not a factor. QUIETLY ELEGANT set the pace along the hedge into the far turn and faded.
