Footnotes

DOCKMASTER allowed to settle, was checked when trapped in behind a wall of horses on the far turn, found room and rallied to draw clear through the final eighth. HOSTILE TAKEOVER checked from tight quarters in the early going, tracked the pace three wide, moved to take over in early stretch but couldn't stay with the winner in the final eighth while continuing on with good courage for the place. PEACEFUL RUSSIAN reserved early, raced three wide around the far turn and closed to be up for the show. HAITIAN unhurried after hitting the gate at the start, swung out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. DANCING CALLING outrun after being steadied when bothered by FALCON'S DREAM soon after the start, improved his position in the drive. TACTICAL STING failed to menace. MY PRECISION bumped hard with SLIM AND NONE at the start, pressed the pace outside OPUS FIVE, moved to gain a slim lead at the quarter pole, maintained that advantage into the stretch, then gave way. BULLSEYE BOY off slowly, was not a factor. OPUS FIVE

set the pace under pressure along the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then tired. SLIM AND NONE bumped soundly with MY PRECISION at the start, chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then nothing left. FALCON'S DREAM swerved out bothering DANCING CALLING soon after the start, then steadied racing into the first turn while showing some early foot and faltered soon after. QUALITEX well placed while saving ground into the far turn, faded.
